# The Christian Hope

Romans 8:18-25 January 21, 2016

# I. The future glory surpasses the present sufferings.

<sup>18</sup> For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us.

cf. Romans 5:2; 8:17; II Corinthians 4:16-18; I Peter 1:3-7; 4:13; 5:10

### II. The creation is waiting.

cf. Psalm 96:11ff; 98:7ff; Isaiah 55:12

# A. Eagerly

<sup>19</sup> For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God.

#### B. Hopefully

1. In subjection to futility

<sup>20</sup> For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of him who subjected it, in hope...

cf. Genesis 3:17ff; Ecclesiastes 1:2

#### 2. In hope of freedom

...that the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption and obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God.

cf. Isaiah 11:6ff; 32:15ff; 35:1ff; 65:17ff; 66:22; Matt. 19:28; Acts 3:19, 21; Rev. 22:3

# C. Groaningly

<sup>22</sup> For we know that the whole creation has been groaning together in the pains of childbirth until now.

cf. Matthew 24:8; Mark 13:8; John 16:20ff

# III. We are waiting.

#### A. Groaningly

<sup>23</sup> And not only the creation, but we ourselves,...

cf. II Corinthians 5:2, 4

### 1. Baptized in the Spirit.

... who have the firstfruits of the Spirit,...

cf. II Corinthians 1:21, 22; 5:5; Galatians 3:14; 5:22-25; Ephesians 1:14

#### 2. Living in two aeons.

... groan inwardly ...

cf. John 15:19; II Corinthians 4:16; James 4:4; I John 2:15

#### B. Eagerly

... as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies.

cf. John 5:21; 6:40, 44; 11:25, 26; I Cor. 15:12-58; Phil. 3:20, 21; I Thess. 4:13-18; I John 3:2

# C. Hopefully

<sup>24</sup> For in this hope we were saved.

cf. Romans 15:4: I Thessalonians 1:3: 5:8

### 1. Without seeing

Now hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for what he sees? cf. II Corinthians 4:18; Hebrews 11:1

#### 2. With patience

<sup>25</sup> But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience. cf. Psalm 27;13, 14; Psalm 130; Psalm 131; Jeremiah 29:10-14
