### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. In the opening verse David expresses an intentional "waiting" for the Lord. What is it about waiting that is so difficult for us?
- 2. Describe a time when God called you to wait for Him. What was that like for you? How did He provide?
- 3. In verse 4, David reflects on the importance of choosing to trust the Lord. What and who are we tempted to trust instead of the Lord when we feel overwhelmed?
- 4. Why does David intentionally appeal to God's "steadfast (covenant) love" and

His "faithfulness?" How do these reassure us when we are waiting for God to act?

## **Going Deeper**

- 1. What are you feeling overwhelmed with right now, or what do you feel you are waiting for from God?
- 2. When the Lord rescued you in the past, what lesson/message ("new song") did He give you to proclaim to others?
