#### Introduction

**Proposition:** Because Jesus died the perfect death and lived the perfect life, we must receive his substitution by faith.

## "Sacrifices and offering you have not desired, but a body you have prepared for me..."

- Suffered God's Wrath (Hebrews 2:17; cf. Romans 3:25; 1 John 2:2, 4:10)
- Made Guilty (Romans 6:23; 2 Corinthians 5:21)
- **Condemned as a Criminal** (Galatians 4:13)
- Made an Enemy of God (Colossians 1:20)

## 2. Active Righteousness (vs. 8-10)

#### "Behold, I have come to do your will."

- **Obeyed in the Same Kind of Body We Have** (Hebrews 2:10-18)
- **Obeyed the Law We Have** (Galatians 4:4-5)
- Lived, Died, Rose to Make Us Obedient (1 Peter 2:24-25)
