 - "sat down...waiting"
 - "perfected..."
- II. Forgiveness (vs. 15-18)
 - "the Holy Spirit also bears witness..."
 - "I will put my laws on their hearts... I will remember their sins no more..."
- III. Confidence (vs. 19-22) | "confidence" "full assurance"
 - "to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus..."
 - "great priest...let us draw near"
 - "sprinkled clean...bodies washed with pure water"
- IV. Confession (vs. 23-25) | "confession of our hope"
 - "he who promised is faithful"
 - "the Day drawing near"
 - "consider how to stir up one another...not neglecting to meet"
