I. Our wisdom is identified by our conduct.

- ... By his good conduct...
- A. Biblical wisdom is knowledge, applied.

 13 Who is wise and understanding among you? ...
- B. Biblical wisdom is demonstrated in humility. ,,,let him show his works in the meekness of wisdom.

II. Worldly wisdom produces a disordered life.

- A. Worldly wisdom is self-centered.
 - ¹⁴ But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast and be false to the truth.
- B. Worldly wisdom is in opposition to God.

 15 This is not the wisdom that comes down from above, but is earthly, unspiritual, demonic.
- C. Worldly wisdom brings destruction.

 16 For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there will be disorder and every vile practice.

III. Godly wisdom produces a centered and purposeful life.

- A. Godly wisdom is a gift from God.
 - ¹⁷ But the wisdom from above...
- B. Godly wisdom is untainted by worldly influence.
 - ... first pure, then peaceable, gentle, open to reason, full of mercy and good fruits, impartial and sincere.

Seven dimensions of pure wisdom:

- 1. Peace-loving
- 2. Considerate
- 3. Open to reason
- 4. Full of mercy
- 5. Full of good works
- 6. Without uncertainty
- 7. Without hypocrisy
- C. Godly wisdom brings restoration.
 - 18 And a harvest of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.
