Why Is There A Different Way For Christians To Settle Disputes?

6:1-6 I. We Have a New <u>Position</u> in Relation to the <u>World</u>.

- :1 A. You have been <u>set apart</u> from the <u>World</u>
 "When one of you has a grievance against another, does he dare go to law before the unrighteous instead of the saints?"
 - :2-3 B. You will be seated with <u>Christ</u> in the <u>Final Judgment</u>
 - Judging the world
 - Judging angels
 - :4-6 C. You are <u>members</u> of a <u>new family</u>
 - Church
 - Brothers

:7-8 II. We Have a New Attitude in Relation to Each Other.

- :7 A. We willingly pay the price for unity
- _:8 B. We do not <u>take advantage</u> of other's <u>vulnerability</u>

:9-11 III. We Have a New <u>Lifestyle</u> in Relation to <u>God's Kingdom</u>

- :9-11a A. Our <u>old life</u> is not <u>compatible</u> with the <u>Kingdom</u> of <u>God</u>
 - Sexual Sins
 - Sins against others
