6:1-6 I. We Have a New Position in Relation to the World.

:1 A. You have been set apart from the World
“When one of you has a grievance against another, does he dare go to law before the unrighteous instead of the saints?”

:2-3 B. You will be seated with Christ in the Final Judgment

- Judging the world
- Judging angels

:4-6 C. You are members of a new family

- Church
- Brothers

:7-8 II. We Have a New Attitude in Relation to Each Other.

:7 A. We willingly pay the price for unity

_ :8 B. We do not take advantage of other's vulnerability

:9-11 III. We Have a New Lifestyle in Relation to God's Kingdom

:9-11a A. Our old life is not compatible with the Kingdom of God
