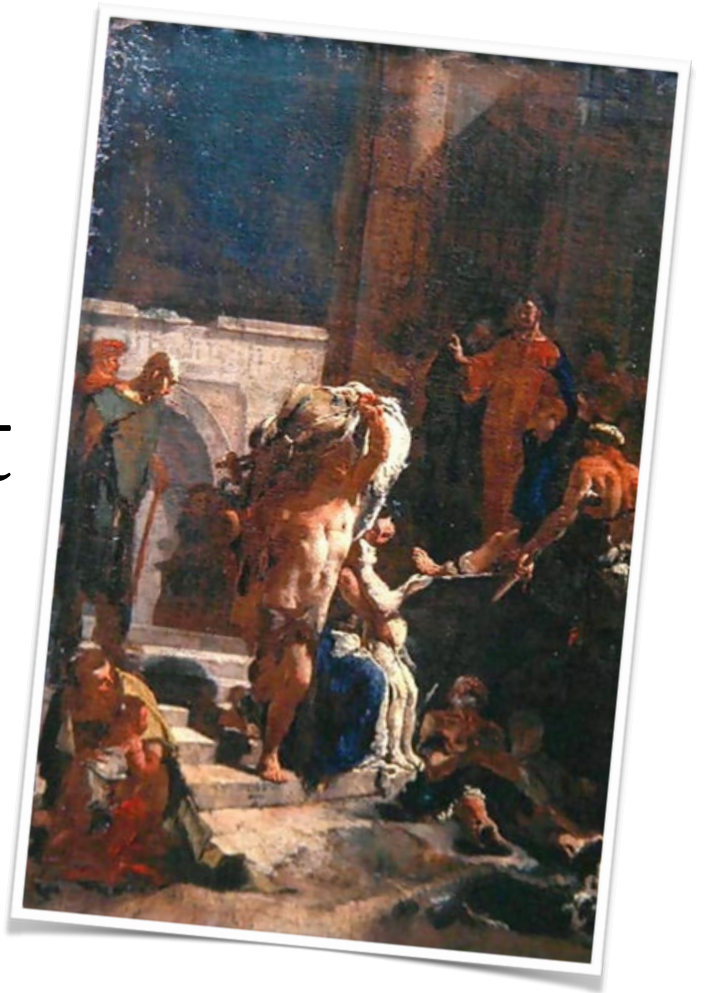

## **Sexual Sins Contrary to Nature**

John 4:1-7

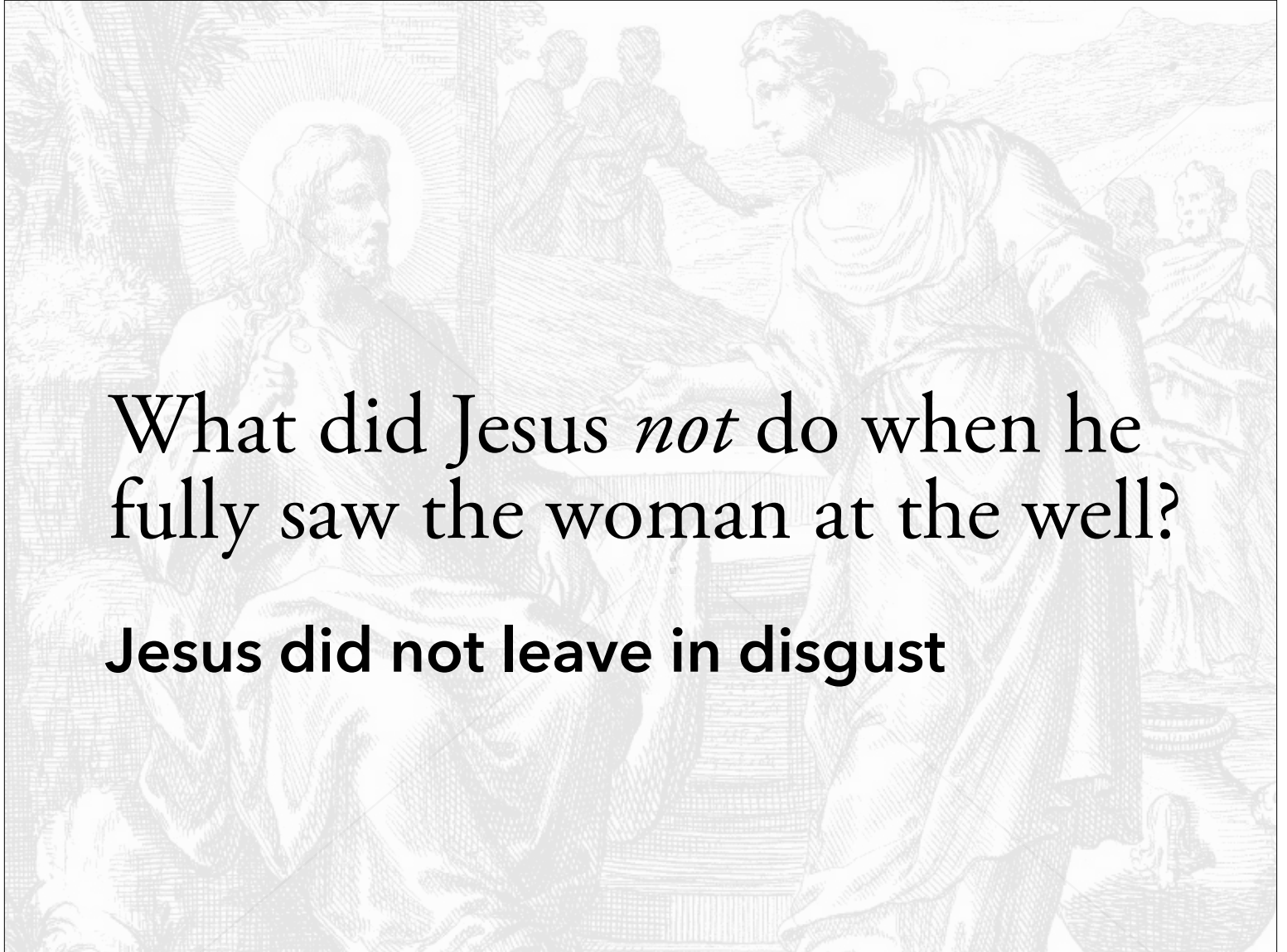
Jesus is our only hope for satisfaction!

John 4:8-15




Jesus fully sees us in our need
