I. All have sinned and all are under God's wrath.

- A. Including:
 - 1. The pagan Gentile.
 - 2. The religious Jew.
 - 3. The moralist.
- B. The sin of the moralist is hypocrisy. cf. Romans 7; I Corinthians 2:15; Matthew 7:1-6

II. Our hypocrisy is inexcusable and God's judgment is inescapable.

- A. We deceive ourselves. cf. Matthew 5:21-30
- B. We presume upon God.
- C. We store up wrath for ourselves.
- D. The Day of Judgment is coming.

III. God's judgment is righteous.

- A. Judged by deeds.
- B. Works are not the basis of salvation, but they are evidence of a saving faith. cf. Psalm 62:12; Romans 3:28; 4:5; 5:1; 8:33; Philippians 2:12-13

IV. God's judgment is impartial.

- A. All men are sinners. cf. Romans 3:23
- B. We will all be judged, with or without the law. cf. John 8:39-47
- C. The rule of judgment is knowledge. cf. Acts 4:12
- D. The Gospel is our only hope.
