I. The Gospel Messenger is Divinely Appointed (v. 1)

A. Unlikely

" Paul,"

B. Devoted

"a servant of Jesus Christ "

C. Commissioned

"...called to be an apostle...

- **1. Eyewitness of resurrected Jesus**
- 2. Commissioned personally by Jesus
- 3. Signs and Wonders

D. Sanctified

"...set apart for the gospel of God ... "

II. The Gospel Message is Divinely Revealed(2-5)

A. Foretold by God's Prophets (2) *"...which he promised beforehand through his prophets in the holy Scriptures..."*

77 quotations from the Old Testament

B. Focused on God's Son (3, 4)

Jesus – 37 times Christ – 66 times **1. Human Genealogy (3)** "...concerning his Son, who was descended from David according to the flesh..."

Cf. II Samuel 7:2-16; Is. 11:1-5; Jer. 23:5,6; Ez. 34:23, 24

2. Divine Sonship (4a)

"...and was declared to be the Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness by his resurrection from the dead..." Cf. Mt. 14:33; 16:16; Lk.1:35; 4:41; John 1:49; 10:36; 11:27; 20:31

3. Lordship (4b)

"...Jesus Christ our Lord..." Cf. Phil. 2:11; Col. 1:15-20

C. Designed for God's Purposes (5)

Cf. Rom. 16:25-27

1. For Spiritual Fruit

"...through whom we have received grace and apostleship to bring about the obedience of faith...."

Cf. Rom. 1-8; 12-15

2. To Glorify God

"...through whom we have received grace and apostleship to bring about the obedience of faith..."

Cf. Rom. 11:33-36; 16:25-27

3. Among all Nations

"...among all the nations..."

Cf. Rom. 16:26; Mt. 28:19; Jn. 10:16

III. The Gospel People are Divinely Called (6-7a)

A. To belong to Jesus (6)

"...including you are called to belong to Jesus Christ...."

B. To remain in this world (7a)

"...to all those in Rome...."

C. To be loved by God (7b)

"...who are loved by God..."

D. To be saints (7c)

"...and called to be saints..."

IV. The Gospel Blessings are Divinely Given (7b)

A. The Gospel Blesses (7b) *"Grace to you and peace...."*

Cf. Is. 9:6, 7; Jn. 14:27

- 1. Peace with God Romans 5:1
- 2. Peace of God Phil. 4:7
- 3. Peace with Neighbor Rom. 12:18
- 4. Peace with Created Order Is. 11:6-9

B. God is the Giver (7c)

"...from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ."

- 2. What is the gospel? Why is it "good news?"
- 3. Why is it essential to the gospel that Jesus Christ be both fully human and fully God? Why do many today deny these truths?
- 4. Describe how the gospel is designed in such a way that it is a blessing to everybody of all ages and all cultures through all time.
- 5. What does Paul say in verses 6 and 7 about his people that is especially encouraging to you? Why?
