The Fruitful Gospel: Kindness – Galatians 5:16-26

I. The <u>fruit</u> of <u>the Spirit</u> is <u>kindness</u>.

5:22

:25, 26

:17

"But the fruit of the Spirit is ... kindness ... "

A. God is kind.

cf. Psa. 34:8; 136:1; Rom. 2:4; 11:22; Titus 3:3-8

B. God's people are kind.

"Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other." cf. Matt. 5:43-48; Lk. 6:27-36; I Cor. 13:4; II Cor. 6:6

II. <u>Kindness</u> is <u>contrary</u> to our <u>fallen nature</u>.

"For the sinful nature desires what is contrary to the Spirit and the Spirit what is contrary to the sinful nature."

A. We must forgive rather than retaliate. "The acts of the sinful nature are obvious...hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, :19-21a selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy..." cf. Luke 23:34; John 8:1-11; Acts 7:59, 60; II Tim. 4:16

> B. We must serve rather than be served. cf. Lk. 7:11-17, 36-50; 8:40-56; 10:25-37; 13:1-17; 18:15-17; 23:34; John 8:1-11; 13:1-17; 19:25-27
